# Respond to snared animals

# Remove snares

- A snare is an anchored **noose** used to capture animals, made from rope, cable, plastic or wire.
- Hunting without a permit and hunting with snares is **illegal** according to the Nature Conservation Ordinance No. 19 of 1974.
- This illegal hunting method is **indiscriminate and cruel** and takes a toll on the entire ecosystem.



If you discover a **live animal** caught in a snare:  
 **call the Snare Free hotline: 076 127 8485**

Keep your distance from the animal and have the following information ready:

- Location of the animal (GPS coordinates/pin preferable)
  - Animal species/description (if known)
  - Your name and contact number
